FACTS	WHAT DOES WHITEGATE INVESTMENT COUNSELORS, INC. (WICI) DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?		
Why?	Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Definitions		
Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.	
Nonaffiliates	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.	
Joint Marketing	A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you. This may include banks, credit unions, or other financial institutions with which we have a joint marketing agreement.	

Other Important Information

Information for California, North Dakota, and Vermont Customers:

In response to applicable state law, if the mailing address provided for your account is California, North Dakota, or Vermont, we will automatically treat your account as if you do not want us to disclose your personal information to non-affiliated third parties for purposes of them marketing to you, except as permitted by the applicable state law.

California, North Dakota, and Vermont clients have other protections under state law. If your primary mailing address is in California or Vermont, we will not share your credit or financial information that we collect except as permitted by law, including, for example, with your consent or to service your account. We will also not use your information for joint marketing purposes. We do not share client information with third parties except as permitted by law.

California residents may be eligible to exercise consumer privacy rights under the California Consumer Privacy act or "CCPA" (Cal. Civ. Code §1798.100 et seq.). This notice is provided according to the CCPA, and, if eligible, you may exercise the following rights. You have the right to know about the personal information collected, disclosed, or sold. Please contact as directed above or use the mail-in form provided at the end of this notice.

- 1. We may collect information about your employment, financial, location, and government-issued information.
- 2. We may obtain personal information directly from the individual or government entities to provide, maintain and service your account(s). We may also utilize this information for:
 - Compliance/legal and regulatory purposes
 - Identity protection/fraud prevention/safety and security
 - Client concerns/complaints
- 3. We may provide information to the following third (3rd) parties to process transactions and maintenance of accounts:
 - Service providers
 - Operating systems and platforms
 - Government entities
 - Data analytics
 - Affiliates (when applicable)

Sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes – information about your creditworthiness Affiliates from using your information to market to you Sharing for nonaffiliates to market to you As noted above, we currently do not have any affiliates. State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing	
What happens when I limit sharing for an account I hold jointly with someone else?	Your choices will apply to everyone on your account.
